

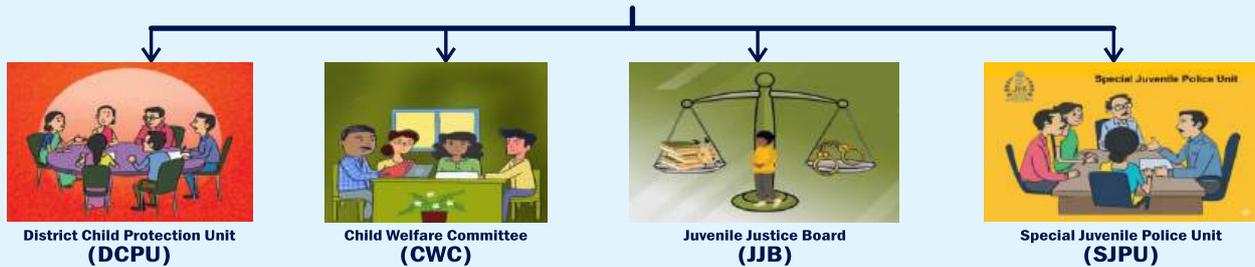
CHILD PROTECTION SYSTEM

What is Child Protection?

- Child protection is the prevention of or responding to the incidence of abuse, exploitation, discrimination, violence and neglect of children.
- This includes sexual exploitation, trafficking, child labour and harmful traditional practices, including child marriage.
- Keeping children safe from real or perceived risks to their lives or childhood, recognising that children are vulnerable and hence reducing their vulnerability by protecting them from harm and harmful situations, including suicide.

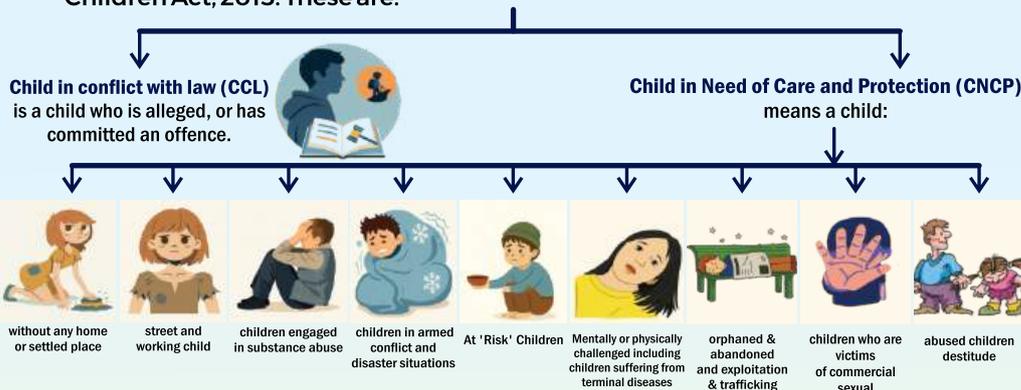


Child Protection Structures at the District level
