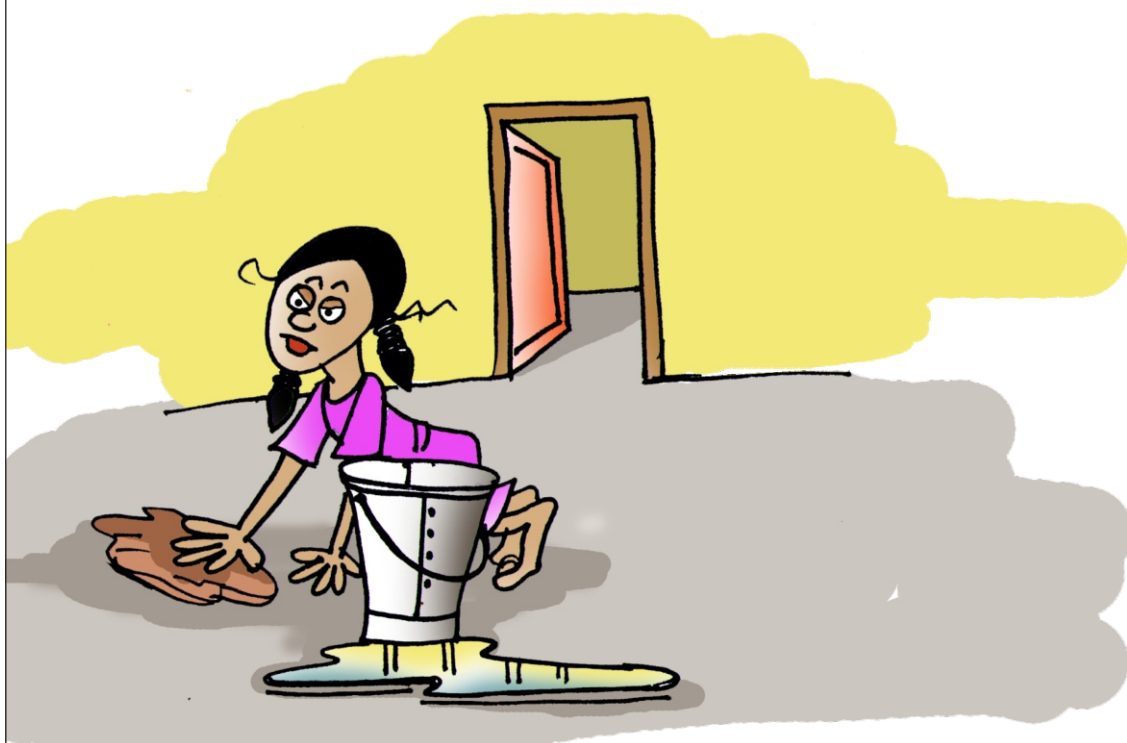

The punishment for violating the
Child Labour (Prohibition & Regulation)
Amendment Act, 2016
can be upto **3 year imprisonment**,
Rs. 20,000-50,000 penalty or both

violating their Right to Education
and is also **punishable** under
Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976
